SOMEC: NEW ORDERS FOR MADE-IN-ITALY LUXURY CRUISES WORTH 60 MILLION EUR

The Somec Group has acquired new orders in the Seascape division - Marine Glazing and Marine Cooking Equipment segments.

The most updated declaration from the major global shipowners talks about, booking trends for 2021 in line with the historical ranges, a percentage of 50-60% of the booked guests that chose to delay the cruise instead of the refunding option." Oscar Marchetto, Chairman of Somec, has declared "I'm deeply persuaded that the tourism segment that can catch the recovery of the new normality more quickly and on a large scale is the cruise segment. Space organization, better liveability, respect for the environment and the community; those are new ways, and new signs of an emerging trend began before the pandemic. Somec is accustomed in working on projects that take their final shapes two or three years in the future, and the future we can foresee from the request and the projects we have been assigned seems brighter".

"In line with our objectives, these new orders confirm the ability of Somec in winning projects that can deploy synergies between different business lines; the acknowledgement of the group as an excellent partner focused on project quality" continued Oscar Marchetto. "The new order allows us in expressing our design and engineering abilities at our best, in the interesting luxury segment: vessels designed to offer a unique cruising experience, with exclusive itineraries, more space with fine finishes.
