

SOMEC RANKS HIGHER ON ESG PERFORMANCE ACCORDING TO SUSTAINALYTICS

In the overall ranking of companies, the Group ranks 33rd out of 140, climbing 10 places since 2021 while improving its risk rating by two points.

Compared to 4 other peers, the Treviso-based Group's performance scored the best Esg Risk Rating.

San Vendemiano (Treviso), 10 November 2022 – Somec S.p.A., a company listed on the Euronext Milan market (Italian Stock Exchange) and specialising in the engineering, production and commissioning of complex turnkey projects in the civil and naval engineering sector, announced that it had its 2021 ESG performance rated by Sustainalytics, one of the world's leading independent companies that rates Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) performance.

Somec voluntarily underwent the rating process with a view to improving transparency towards its stakeholders and further strengthening its approach to the Group's sustainability journey.

The rating, in detail, measures exposure to industry-specific material ESG risks and how effectively the company manages these risks.

Somec was awarded an ESG risk rating of 22.5, a two-point improvement compared to previous year (24.5). This rating also allowed Somec to move up in the overall ranking of the companies being monitored, where it ranked 33rd out of 140, up ten places from 43rd place (out of 133 companies) last year.

This improvement also enabled the company to position itself at the lower end of the range in the medium risk band (20-30). As benchmarked against four other peers on a like-for-like basis in terms of market capitalisation, Somec scored the best Esg Risk Rating.

Oscar Marchetto, Chairman of Somec, commented: "We are pleased with this result as it bears out the Group's focus on improving factors related to environmental, social and corporate governance issues. We are sharing this achievement with all those within SOMEC who strive every day to promote more transparent governance models, measure and improve our environmental footprint, gain deeper insights into our social and economic impact on the local area and devise and implement corporate strategies geared towards improving our sustainability."
