

SOMEC: TSI (MESTIERI DIVISION) SECURES CONTRACT WORTH OVER 41 MILLION EURO FOR BESPOKE INTERIORS ON THREE CRUISE SHIPS

The design phase is set to begin in 2027 for the dining and entertainment areas on the world's three largest cruise ships.

San Vendemiano (TV), February 18, 2026 - Somec S.p.A. (Euronext Milan: SOM), specialising in the engineering, production, and deployment of complex turnkey projects in the civil and naval sector, has secured a new contract worth over 41 million Euro for its *Mestieri: Design and Production of Bespoke Interiors* Division through its subsidiary TSI (Total Solution Interiors).

The contract covers three cruise ships of a new design class, under construction by a leading Italian shipbuilding group for a major North American cruise operator with an international footprint.

Deliveries are scheduled for 2029, 2031, and 2033. Design activities are slated to get underway as early as 2027, with the first vessel serving as the lead ship for the new platform. The economic impact is expected to be realised between 2027 and 2032.

With a gross tonnage of approximately 230,000 GT and a maximum capacity in the region of 8,000 passengers, these vessels rank among the largest currently under construction globally in the cruise sector.

TSI will be responsible for the design, production, and outfitting of approximately 5,800 square metres of public areas per ship, primarily located on Deck 8. The scope of work comprises the creation of approximately ten themed restaurants and bars—including a dedicated brewery—alongside a complex system of family-oriented spaces. These will feature a large video-game arcade, a Treehouse connected to the main Promenade via two internal slides, and an extensive area dedicated to children and teenagers.

Against a backdrop of increasing vessel size and high design complexity, TSI's role as a single point of contact ensures integrated oversight across the entire project lifecycle—from engineering to final execution—delivering key benefits in terms of coordination, schedule control, and guaranteed deliverables. Intensive design and technical development activities will get underway immediately, cementing *Mestieri's* positioning in high-end bespoke projects and complex manufacturing challenges.

This contract marks the largest ever secured by TSI, ensuring long-term visibility for its operations over several years.

Oscar Marchetto, Somec Chairman, pointed out that: *"This contract represents a pivotal milestone in the growth of Mestieri and underscores the Group's ability to operate on next-generation platforms, characterised by their considerable scale and design complexity. The early launch of these activities bolsters our multi-year backlog visibility and cements our positioning in the large cruise ship segment, which continues to drive significant international investment and sustained growth dynamics."*
